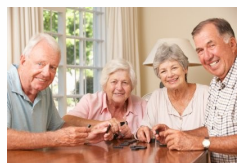

BURRILLVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT

B-SAFE PROGRAM – Security & Awareness for Elderly Residents. Register and a site file will be created with all pertinent information on the residence, readily providing dispatchers & officers with location information when receiving a call. Personal phone calls can be made every few weeks to check in with the resident/s.

SPECIAL NEEDS REGISTRY

Burrillville residents register using a state-wide form and are checked on during emergency situations.

SENIOR SERVICES OFFICER

Can check in and provide information and services, such as connecting with statewide Senior Services agencies

SHOVELING PROGRAM

Residents register and are connected to teenage volunteers who will shovel them out after storms.
